Disc Dog Training Seminar

The Disc Dog Training is a one hour clinic for basic and intermediate levels. Following a skills assessment, instructions will include: basic throwing, how to motivate your dog to catch the disc, basic fetch and retrieve, tricks and throws for freestyle, instructions on Skyhoundz competition.

This seminar is recommended for dogs with disc, ball or toy drive. Chasing/tracking and retrieval instincts are needed. Consult your veterinarian before starting your dog on any form of athletic training program. A well thought out conditioning, stretching, warm-up and cool-down will improve your canine's performance and prevent injury.

Prerequisite Training

This is an off leash sport. Dogs need to be properly socialized, and basic obedience is strongly recommended as they will most certainly come into contact with other dogs.
